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Convergence Quilt – Part 2

This class is for anyone who has made a Convergence Quilt and would like to do more with the technique. We will do Project Two from the book – Divide and Conquer Convergence.

Supplies

- Book Ricky Tims' Convergence Quilts
- Two fat quarters of fabric. Batiks recommended as these are easier to work with and you can use both sides to give more options. Bring two contrasting fabrics that have an overall color or print. Fabrics should NOT be similar in appearance or be large scale prints. Refer to Page 42 Fabric Selection in the book for more detail. Bring a selection of fabrics if you want help to decide.
- Rotary cutter with SHARP blade
- Large cutting mat
- 24" acrylic ruler. Quilters Select ruler highly recommended.
- Thread to blend with your fabrics
- Fabric markers that show on your fabrics
- Straight pins
- Purple thang, stylus or pencil with eraser
- Sewing machine with ¼" piecing foot and a clear plastic foot if you have. A clear foot is helpful to see where you are going on the curved piecing.
- Sewing machine manual
- Small iron and ironing surface for your work space. Can be shared by two people.
- Spray bottle or mister for ironing
