

**Tomorrow's Treasurers**  
**Bowl Me Over Purse**  
**Supply List Required Before Class**

1) Basic sewing supplies:

- Sharp Fabric Scissors, blade at least 4" long
- Strong straight Pins long yellow -topped quilting pins
- Tap Measure 60" long, plastic, not cloth
- Metal seam guide 5-6" long
- Seam Ripper
- Thread to match your fabrics
- Standard foot, edge foot, zipper foot for your sewing machine
- Erasable/water soluble Fabric Marker or chalk marker
- Wonder Clips (if available bring multiple sizes from small to large)
- Stiletto or Awl
- 90/14 Topstitch sewing machine needles, you may need 2-4 for class
- Mini Iron with pressing mat
- Ruler 24"
- 12mm ½" bias tape maker for making zipper pulls
- Bobbin and turning tool for handle and strap cover (suggest, Quick Turn Fabric Tube Turning Tool)
- Sewing Machine

**NOTE: Key decisions to make before class:**

- Determine your border accent on the outside zipper pocket B & A flap pocket. In the store sample I used the lining fabric
- Bias binding is mostly used to bind the inside of the bag. Consider using the lining fabric or another coordinating fabric. You will need to purchase an additional 2/3 of a yard of your chosen fabric. Also the outside pocket A and flap is bound with a contrasting fabric. In the store sample I used an additional contrasting fabric for this binding and the zipper pulls; 2/3 of a yard works
- If you are using faux leather for your handles and shoulder strap **DONOT** make these handles before class

## 2) Bowl Me Over Purse

- Pattern is Bowl Me Over 2.0 by Annie available at Tomorrow's Treasurers
- Purchase all fabric and notions per the back of the pattern, except for the following:
  - Zippers, if you choose not to use zippers by the yard for all the zippers needed, use 2-14" sport zipper for outside pocket and inside pocket. You will need 1- 30" double slide sport zipper for the bag closing zipper
  - Interfacing, I used SFP101 fusible as a substitution for SUP179 listed on the pattern and it worked great
  - Bring all leftover extra fabric to class
  - Consider using ribbons to match for zipper pulls instead of coordinating fabric
  - Purchase an additional 2/3 yard of lining or other contrasting fabric for bias binding to coordinate with lining and main fabric. Store sample has 2 ¼" wide bias binding
  - No base stabilizer is used in the store sample purse. The purse was stable without the base stabilizer.
  - Magnetic closure – store sample uses a 1/2" small magnetic snap in lieu of the 14mm sew-in magnet. If you use this magnetic snap it is not necessary to cut the facing for the front flap and pocket. Also there is no need for any fusible interfacing.
  - Handle option 1 or 2?; the store sample is option 1 which is the shorter handle with a shoulder strap; option 2 is a longer handle, no shoulder strap.

## 3) Pre-Work Required,

- Section I - Cut and quilt all pieces as listed on page 2 and 3 of the pattern (See page 16 of the pattern for labels)
- Cut the bias binding either using the method listed in the pattern on page 1 or use your favorite bias binding cutting method. Please sew all pieces of bias binding together. Store sample uses 2 ¼" wide.
- It is very helpful to mark your pieces as you cut them, use the printed labels on page 16. Using the labels also helps in picking your main, lining, and coordinating fabrics for the bag and will be necessary to

correctly place your pockets later.

- Trace the 2 ½", 3 ½", and 4 ½" circle from the pattern instructions
- **DONOT round any corners before class.**
- Consider doing the following before class:
  - Preparing the handles D., page 4. If you are using a faux leather fabric for your handles and shoulder strap **DONOT** make your handles before class.
  - Zipper Pulls C., page 4

### **NOTE: Sewing Machines:**

You must bring along with your sewing machines the following:

1. All sewing machine accessories, feet (referenced above), screw driver, etc.
2. Must have owner's manual for your machine
3. Bring 2 extra bobbins with no thread
4. Remember to bring the power cord and foot pedal
