Tomorrow's Treasurers Chicken Mini Iron Tote Supply List Required Before Class

1) Basic sewing supplies:

- Sharp Fabric Scissors, blade at least 4" long
- Straight Pins at least 1 ¼ " long with a colored head (not craft pins)
- Tap Measure 60" long, plastic, not cloth
- Metal seam guide 5-6" long
- Seam Ripper
- Thread to match your fabrics
- Standard foot, edge foot, zipper foot for your sewing machine
- Erasable/water soluble Fabric Marker or chalk marker
- Wonder Clips
- Stiletto or Awl
- 90/14 or 80/12 universal needle
- Turning tool for handle
- Small iron with pressing mat
- Sewing Machine

NOTE: Store sample is the largest tote, with sport zipper; all are available at Tomorrow's Treasures

2) Chicken Mini Iron Tote

- Pattern is Winging Kit, pattern #JHQ237, by Java House Quilts, available at Tomorrow's Treasurers
- Purchase all fabric and notions per the back of the pattern for your chosen size, except for the following:
 - o Zippers, 1-14" sport zippers
 - Fusible foam stabilizer, I used Insul-bright to make the iron tote safe for hot irons
 - Interfacing, I used SFP101 fusible for the med-weight fusible stabilizer and it worked great
 - Wings my sample the wings are larger and shaped more like a wing. I used 100% cotton batting (10" X 10") for the wings.
 This wing pattern will be available at class. Insul-bright can be used instead of the batting to make the wings more puffy.

- Handle is 22" long and 2 ¼" wide with SF101 fused to half of the handle (22" long by 1 1/8" wide)
- Please make sure to bring your rice filling for the feet to class.
- Bring all leftover extra fabric to class
- o Ribbon to match for zipper pulls instead of coordinating fabric

3) Pre-Work Required,

- Trace your pattern pieces for your chosen size.
- Quilt the body sections for the body and the belly per the pattern instructions on page 1.
- **FYI**: Your belly fabric will be on the bottom of the tote.
- Then cut our your pattern pieces. Now sew an 1/8" all the way around your pattern pieces to seal the edges.
- Wings, the store sample the belly fabric is not used for the wings and it is not quilted.

NOTE: Sewing Machines:

You must bring along with your sewing machines the following:

- 1. All sewing machine accessories, feet (referenced above), screw driver, etc.
- 2. Must have owner's manual for your machine
- 3. Bring 2 extra bobbins with no thread
- 4. Remember to bring the power cord and foot pedal
