## Supply list for Serger Bin

- Sixteen 10-inch squares; 8 for the exterior and 8 for the lining. You can use a layer cake grouping or you can use coordination scraps as long as they are 10 inch by 10 inch.
- One 4 inch by 30 inch strip of coordination fabric for the flower. I used 3 of the 10 inch squares from the layer cake group for the sample flower.
- Large button for the center of the flower
- Two 19 % inch squares of single sided fusible In-R Form or any foam batting
- Eigh 9 ½ inch squares of Pellon SF101 interfacing. About 1½ yards of SF101.
- Four spools serger threads in color that coordinates with fabric
- Two spools of 12 wt. thread. I used Sulky 12wt. thread for the sample. You can use variegated or solid color.
- Serger in good working order. Please bring your machine, machine manual, new serger needles, machines tools.
- Basic sewing supplies: scissors, ruler, pins.
- Prior to class please have the following completed:
  - Cut all 10 inch squares for the outside and lining of the bag
  - $\circ$  Cut foam batting into two 19 ½ inch squares
  - Cut SF101 into 8 9 ½ inch squares.
