Easy Quilt As You Go

Reversible quilt using a quilt-as-you-go technique. Both sides of this quilt are finished at the same time.

Supplies listed here are for a medium sized, approximately 37" x 49" quilt. You will receive instructions to make this quilt in class.

Supplies

*Sewing machine in good working order and sewing machine manual. Know how to thread it, wind a bobbin, adjust your tension, and sew a straight and zigzag stitch. You will need to lengthen your zigzag stitch.

*Walking foot for your machine – A MUST!

*Non directional fabrics - 1/4 yard for center front

¼ yard for center back

1 ¼ yards for Fabric A front

¾ yard for Fabric B front

1 ¼ yards for Fabric C back

¾ yard for Fabric D back

^{*1/2} yard of fabric for binding – stripe, solid or print

^{*}Batting – 1 package crib size (48" x 60") cotton batting.

^{*}Thread to blend with your fabrics. A neutral color such as gray or tan will work.

^{*}Rotary cutter with a sharp blade, cutting mat and 6" x 24" quilting ruler.

^{*}Basic sewing supplies - straight pins, scissors, marking pencil or pen, seam ripper, paper and pen. Post-it notes or flags are also helpful to number your strips.

^{*}Optional – Small iron and ironing surface to use at your space. You can share.

^{*}Your lunch and a drink.
