Easy Flowy Dress Beginner Class #4 Supply List Required Before Class

- 1) Basic sewing supplies:
 - Sharp Fabric Scissors, blade at least 4-6" long
 - Straight Pins at least 1 ¼" long with a colored head (not craft pins)
 - Tap Measure 60" long, plastic, not cloth
 - Metal seam guide 5-6" long
 - Seam Ripper
 - Erasable Fabric Marker or chalk marker
 - 80/12 Universal needles
 - Pinking shears (optional)
 - Small iron and pressing mat
 - Sewing Machine
- 1) Easy Flowy Dress
 - Choose either multi-size pattern New Look 6340 or 6347 both available on Amazon.
 - Determine your size by using your hip and bust measurement. Based on your size purchase the fabric amount recommended on the back of the pattern. The New Look pattern 6347 has two length and three neckline options. The New Look pattern 6340 has two hemlines and three neckline options. (the store sample is 6340 view A with pockets) Be sure to purchase the correct amount based on your chosen lengthen and neckline. I recommend any of the Batik fabrics, chambray, lightweight cotton or cotton lawn all available at Tomorrow's Treasures.
 - No plaids, circular stripes, or border prints, directional prints are OK but you will need to purchase an additional 1 yard of your chosen fabric
 - Check the back of the pattern under Requirements to make sure you have all the notions and accessories needed for your chosen dress style
 - Interfacing please purchase woven fusible interfacing SF101 for dress pattern 6340 available at Tomorrow's Treasures
 - Bias Binding Feel free to purchase ready-made bias binding as described on the back of the pattern. Another option is to make your own bias binding to match your dress fabric. Please purchase an

extra ½ yard of fabric to make matching bias binding. Instructions on how to do this technique will be shown in class.

- Pre-wash your fabric <u>before class</u>. Do not pre-wash your interfacing
- Thread to match fabric

NOTE: Sewing Machines:

For those students who have sewing machines they must bring along with their sewing machines the following:

- 1. Before class you must know how to thread your sewing machine and the bobbin
- 2. Must bring all the sewing machine attachments, feet, screw driver, etc.
- 3. Must have owner's manual for your machine
- 4. Bring 1 extra bobbin with no thread
- 5. Remember to bring the power cord and foot pedal
